What?

NOAH CAN is a collaboration across suburbs, people, businesses, but most importantly neighbours in need, as a result of COVID-19.

There are families in dire need. Individuals, communities, corporates, ratepayer and resident associations are coming together to ensure that we address the immediate needs of our neighbours.



Who?



NOAH has signed up with Gauteng together, where some early best practice on the identification of needs and coordination of delivery, have been shared.

The project, which was pioneered by Cape Town Together, is being adopted in Gauteng in response to growing concerns over food insecurity, hunger and other social challenges impacting negatively on the lives of people due to the lockdown.

Gauteng Together will mobilise ordinary people to initiate Community Action Networks (CAN) in their neighbourhoods; to identify community needs, and to work towards addressing them through co-ordinated, sustained localised action.



How?

Already the ratepayer and residents' associations are working together on projects such as the community policing forum. Conversations have been initiated and we're committed to collaboration, but we need your help.

While we plan to address those in our immediate vicinity, we're about community and neighbours and artificial borders such as suburbs and wards will not dictate our reach.

You are our most important asset in this community action network, so ask how you can get involved. If you are one of the more fortunate and go to sleep each night warm and fed, know that there are families who are not so lucky, right around the corner.

We need to clearly identify the needs and then match them, so that we take care of each person in need, as far as possible.
